

ABOUT QUINNIPIAC UNIVERSITY

As the University embraces its next exciting chapter, the Quinnipiac community is seeking a strategic and visionary leader who will strengthen and amplify its unique identity as the university of the future. Quinnipiac University prides itself on delivering an innovative, market-driven education that prepares students for 21st-century careers. By nurturing the whole person, the University also equips graduates to thrive and adapt to life's diverse challenges and opportunities. Despite the headwinds facing higher education, Quinnipiac has met or exceeded its enrollment targets in the last three years. Quinnipiac is well-positioned for the future and the University requires a President with a sense of innovation and entrepreneurship and a commitment to the academic excellence of our distinctive programs.

A private, coeducational, nonsectarian institution located 90 minutes north of New York City and two hours from Boston, Quinnipiac enrolls 6,248 full-time undergraduate and 2,670 graduate and part-time students in 100 degree programs through its Schools of Business, Communications, Education, Engineering, Health Sciences, Law, Medicine, Nursing, and College of Arts and Sciences. The University consistently ranks among the top national universities according to U.S. News & World Report's America's "Best Colleges" issue. Quinnipiac also is recognized in Princeton Review's "The 389 Best Colleges," and is in U.S. News' top 100 Best Value Schools. Quinnipiac University has been ranked as the number one school for getting a job, based on successful career placement following graduation (Zippia.com).

Quinnipiac University prepares students for future careers through hands-on learning, investment in in-demand fields, and promoting intellectual agility. The University is dedicated to building an inclusive and excellence-driven community by enhancing curricula, recruitment, and support for students, faculty, and staff. One of the University's core strategic pillars is to create an inclusive, excellence-driven community, and the University recently completed a reimagining of the Office of Inclusive Excellence, which is now fully staffed. Quinnipiac positively impacts local and global communities by fostering physical and mental wellness and enriching university life with investments in facilities and programs. Additionally, the University aims to create lifelong connections and success by offering numerous opportunities for engagement, networking, emotional bonds, and career growth.

The Quinnipiac Schools of Medicine, Nursing, and Health Sciences come together on an integrated healthcare campus with innovative resources and a community-minded, interprofessional approach to patient-focused healthcare. Interdisciplinary opportunities with QU's six other schools and through our comprehensive partnerships with healthcare institutions, organizations, and agencies produce a dynamic learning environment that reflects the real-world, integrated nature of how our nation's healthcare system operates.

Evidence of the University's upward trajectory is abound, including the opening of a new Rec & Wellness Center in 2023, and The Grove, a new residence hall welcoming students in the Fall of 2024. The School of Business goes beyond business as usual, equipping future entrepreneurs, marketers, financiers, and other professionals with the tools, practical experiences, and insights they will need to thrive in a quickly evolving business landscape.

As part of a dynamic, energetic campus, Quinnipiac supports <u>21 Division 1 athletic programs</u>, including the 2023 National Champion Men's Ice Hockey Team.

Judy D. Olian, Ph.D., has served as President of Quinnipiac University since July 2018. The University is in the midst of cutting-edge program expansion for both traditional and adult learners, attraction of diverse communities, innovative corporate partnerships, and an ambitious set of capital projects. Among its distinctions are the Quinnipiac University Poll, deep and broad excellence across the health sciences, and graduates who achieve among the very best employment outcomes in the country. President Olian announced that she will be retiring in June of 2025.
