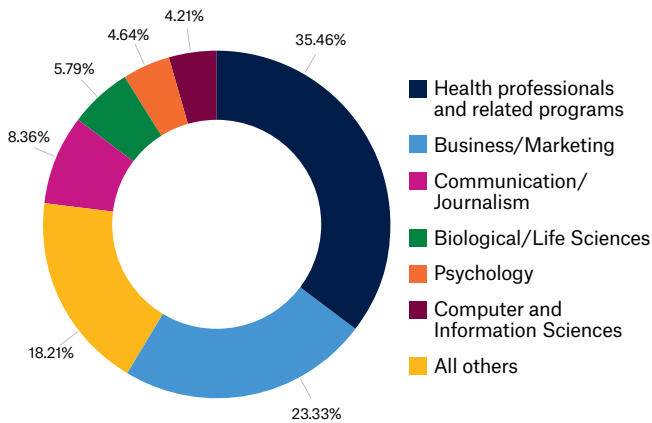


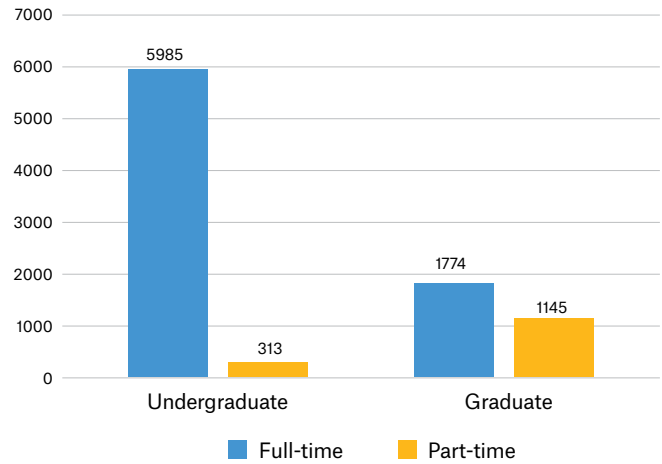
About QU

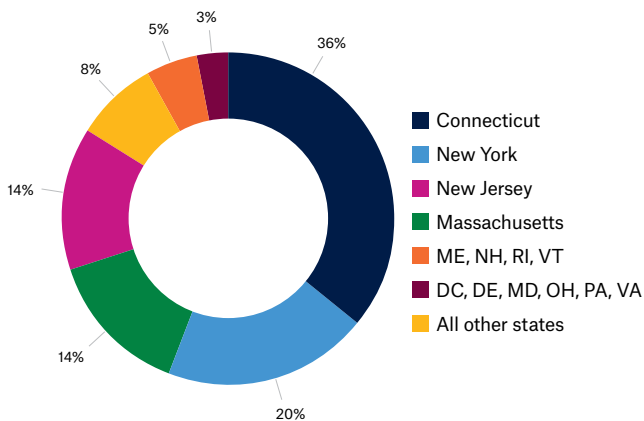
Bachelor's Degree Awarded Last Year



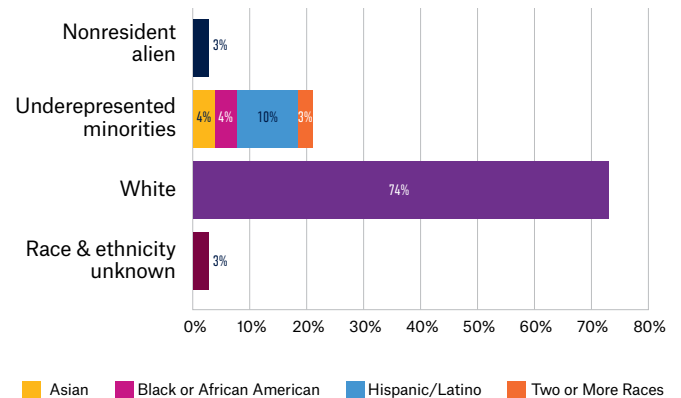
Fall 2021 Enrollment

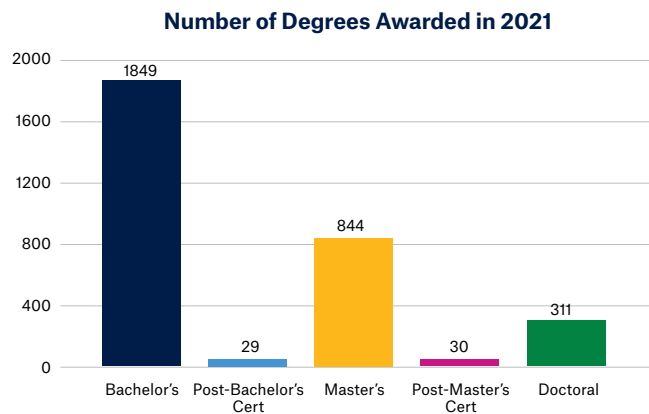
